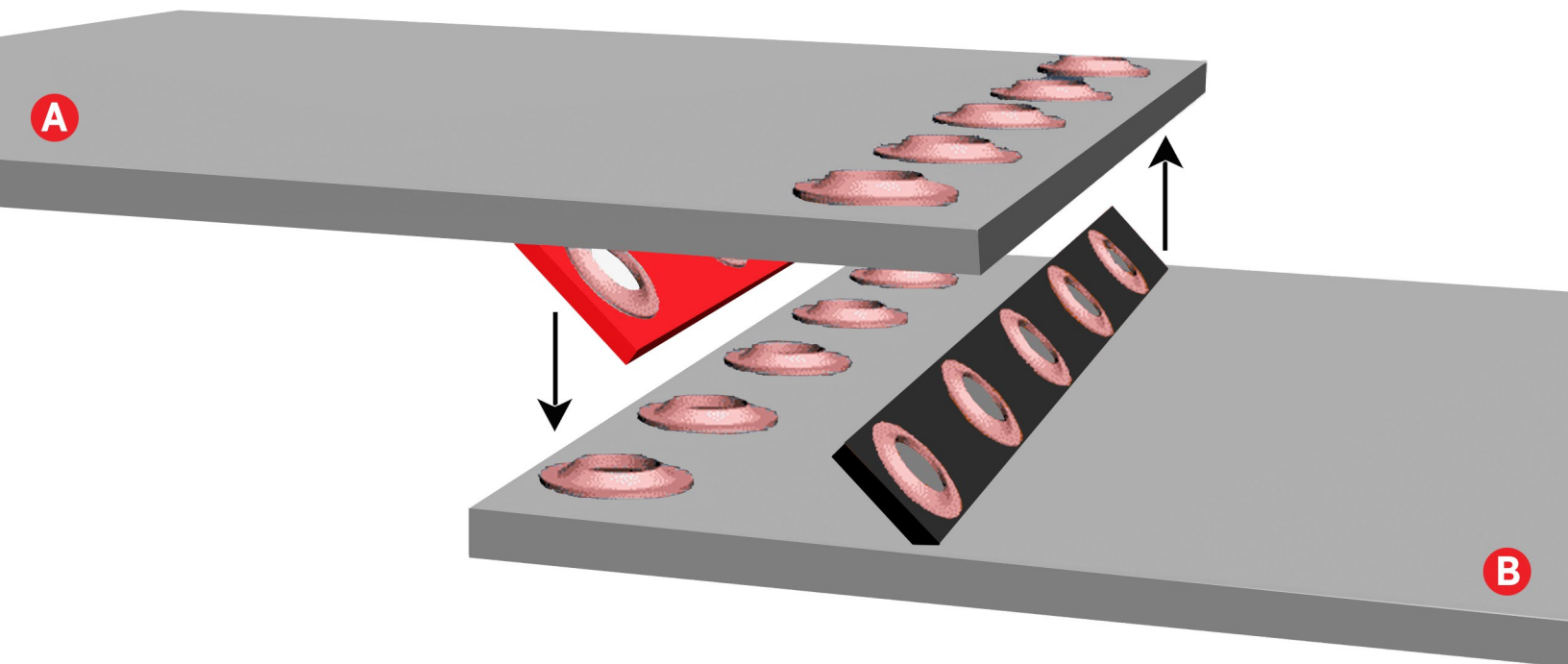




# REVERSE OVERLAP

- Tarps are constructed to allow for a 1 ft. overlapping of adjacent tarps.
- A “Reverse Overlap”, is the most popular way to overlap & connect tarps.
- The overlap of Tarp A connects to the edge of Tarp B, and the overlap of Tarp B connects to the edge of Tarp A.
- Overlap seams can be fabricated onto all four edges of any tarp.



- 1. Align tarps as seen in picture.**
- 2. Connect red flap of Tarp A to the bottom edge of Tarp B.**
- 3. Connect black flap of Tarp B to the top edge of Tarp A with zip ties.**
